- Every visual image attached to the retrieved article(s) related to your key word search at the time of publication
- Every advertisement attached to the retrieved article(s) related to your key word search at the time of publication


How would our Institution use this resource and is it available to both teachers and students?

How do we access The Maclean's Archives?

Access is granted by IP address. We can also provide username and password access if your institution does not have a static IP address.

Our Institution currently has a digital subscription with EBSCO via FLIPSTER. How is this subscription different from The Maclean's Archives?

1. The EBSCO/FLIPSTER subscription only includes current issues and a couple of years of back issues. The Maclean's Archives is the COMPLETE online digital collection including EVERY Maclean's issue since 1905 in a searchable digital format.
2. The FLIPSTER format is a pdf and is not a searchable archive, whereas The Maclean's Archives is searchable by key word, providing hundreds of relevant articles in seconds!

Does your system support EZ proxy so that our students and/or patrons can have access from home? YES!

How much does it cost and is it an annual subscription?

The cost depends on a number of criteria but is based on the FTE's of your school or the number of subscriptions purchased if you are a public library. The Maclean's Archives is sold as an annual subscription. For exact pricing please contact lkirkness@outlook.com.
